

When used in its studio mode the camera head was fitted in a wedge shaped housing with an 8" viewfinder. There was also a 5" viewfinder option.

Developments

Microprocessor control, messages in viewfinder, Auto black, white, iris, centering. Mains or battery operation. A late version was offered, by Crow of Reading, in 1982. It had text status messages in the viewfinder such as "turn gain up".
